Fohhn goes Concert Sound at ISE 2018

South German audio manufacturer presents expanded brand range in new focus on concert sound applications

Nürtingen / Amsterdam, 11th January 2018 – Fohhn Audio AG brings a brand new, comprehensive concert sound system combination to Integrated Systems Europe (ISE) in Amsterdam - **Hall 7, Stand 7-N210**. The South German manufacturer is expanding its range of professional loudspeaker systems for fixed installation- and mobile applications to include products for large live sound venues.

Forming part of this new system combination is **Focus Venue**. The active, digitally controllable line array system with Fohhn Beam Steering Technology consists of flexible, combinable high frequency and low-mid range loudspeaker modules whose beam characteristics can be electronically controlled, via software, in real time. Focus Venue arrays are designed to be stacked and flown straight – mechanical curving is not necessary. On 7th and 8th February, ISE visitors can also experience this new line array system "live" in special demonstrations at the **Q-Factory in Amsterdam**.

Focus Venue can be supplemented in the low frequency range by two **new Perform-Series subwoofers**: the **PS-400** (1 x 18") and **PS-450** (2 x 18"). As required, these can be combined to form horizontal, vertical or endfired Focus Sub Arrays, whose beam characteristics can also be controlled via software.

Further system components include Fohhn's new high performance **DI-Series digital amplifiers**, which are to be available in 2- and 4-channel versions with up to 4000 W output per channel.

In accordance with Fohhn's digital strategy, all components of the new system combination will be available with input interfaces for AES/EBU signals, as well as for Optocore, Dante and Fohhn AIREA digital networks.

Alongside these highlights, ISE visitors can expect to see other new products including the **ABX-5** breakout module, which acts as an interface between the Fohhn AIREA system and the Dante network. Fohhn will also present further variants of its established **CS-04 ceiling loudspeakers**, plus a new pole-operated universal mount for the PT-70 loudspeaker system.

From 6th to 9th February, Fohhn looks forward to welcoming visitors to Stand 7-N210.
